 - b. TONU Kalam: Retired faculty permits?
 - i. It will continue to be available to those faculty members
 - c. Hours for weeknight parking: 5 pm – 7:30 am, Monday through Friday
 - d. Online Maps – available for visual of designated lots across campus
 - e. Student Access will be by fee
 - f. Daytime Employee/Postdoctoral
 - i. Daytime permit honored, \$25 annual option, 20 free passes, \$1
 - ii. Alex Tuttle – all postdocs receive 20 free weeknight passes? Do postdocs have to be part of CAP?
 1. CAP members receive 20 free
 2. Postdocs eligible for \$25 annual weeknight permit.
 - iii. John Brunner – tutors who come to campus?
 1. Can purchase a permit for coverage over a semester.
 - iv. Justin Haslett – how would a CAP member get a weeknight parking permit?
 1. working out processes, but will be like free day pass to print out or a code;
 2. \$1 option if not planned in advance.
 - v. Carlos – Renewal for CAP members annual? 20 passes per year or semester?
 1. Yes, CAP is an annual renewal.
 2. 20 passes per semester

 - i. Alex Tuttle – registration period – is it offered multiple times a year?
 1. Always open, but typically starts May/June/July
 - h. Weeknight ADA
 - i. Process – apply for UNCD permit/access
 - ii. Placards for visitors honored in ADA spaces.
 - i. Visitor: \$1 in designated weeknight lots, hourly parking, metered parking
 - j. Event Operations – categories of patrons/users
 - i. Justin – Question about the mechanics – will parkmobile be available for Cobb Deck?
 1. Cobb Deck will also have a payment station option.
 - k. Meg McGurk – lots off campus, also parkmobile and meter? 440 North and South, Morehead Lot?
 - i. \$1 one-night
 - ii. Justin – will Cobb be ready by beginning of semester?
 1. ParkMobile will be available.
